Aerobatic Boxes (charted by **red box with red X**)

- I. Firebird Box

NOTE: Aerobatic boxes may only be used by authorized pilots. Aerobatic aircraft often maneuver well outside the areas marked on the chart.

Defined Practice Areas

Pan Am International Flight Academy and Westwind School of Aeronautics conduct intensive student training within the entire northwest area.

Turf Soaring (dark blue rings in northwest area)

- A. Surface to 18,000 ft. MSL
- B. 3,000 to 18,000 ft. MSL
- C. 7,000 to 18,000 ft. MSL

UND Aerospace (purple lines in the southeast area)

ATP (dark green lines in southeast area)

Chandler Air Service (red lines in southeast area)

- A. CAS aerobatic box: 1,700 to 5,200 ft. MSL
- B. South practice area
- C. Southwest practice area

NOTE: A-1 through A-4 aerobatic practice areas: 3,700 to 5,200 ft. MSL

Falcon Exec (light blue lines in southeast area)

Estrella Sailport (brown lines in southwest area)

NOTE: 90% of all glider training in area outlined to 6,300 ft. MSL

ATCA (light green lines in southwest area)

- Area A: 3,500 to 8,000 ft. MSL
Area B: Surface to 4,500 ft. MSL
Area C: Surface to 6,500 ft. MSL
Area D: Surface to 5,000 ft. MSL
Area E: Surface to 4,500 ft. MSL
Area F: 3,500 to 6,500 ft. MSL

NOTE: There are other practice areas further west not depicted on chart.
